## Instructions

- 1. Remove existing panel from ceiling grid to expose the source of the leak.
- 2. Clear any debris from T-rail surface and place Leak Diversion System panel into opening.
- Attach ceiling clips to T-rails, spacing them evenly along desired hose route. (The first clip should be attached to the T-rail that supports the Leak Diversiom System panel.)
- 4. Cut drainage hose to length and attach to ceiling clips using adjustable hangers.
- 5. Adjust hangers so drainage hose slopes away from panel. (It may be necessary to join several hangers for longer drops.)
- 6. Firmly press end of hose over barbed outlet in center of panel.
- 7. Direct discharge end of hose to a floor drain or collection container.

## Important Notes:

- The Drop-Ceiling Leak Diversion System is intended for use with water flows of up to 1 gallon per minute.
- Not for use with oils and chemicals
